Caverion has signed a contract with property management company EKZ Grundstücksverwaltung GmbH on delivering building solutions to a new building complex in Stuttgart, Germany. The value of the contract is approximately EUR 14.2 million and it covers the technical disciplines of heating and sanitation, ventilation and air conditioning, security and safety, cooling and automation. Caverion is responsible for project execution.

The new building complex will have nine floors with a total surface area of 38,000 m² and it will house shops, offices and apartments. The installation work of the building solutions will start in October 2015 and is expected to be completed by the end of 2016.

"After the Milaneo and the Münchner Hofstadt, the Dorotheen Quartier represents one more multifunctional city building that Caverion helps to equip with building systems. It shows that we are an established and competent partner in the execution of high-quality and complex projects.
